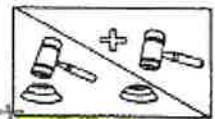

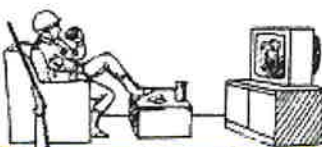


Grand jury

jury decision

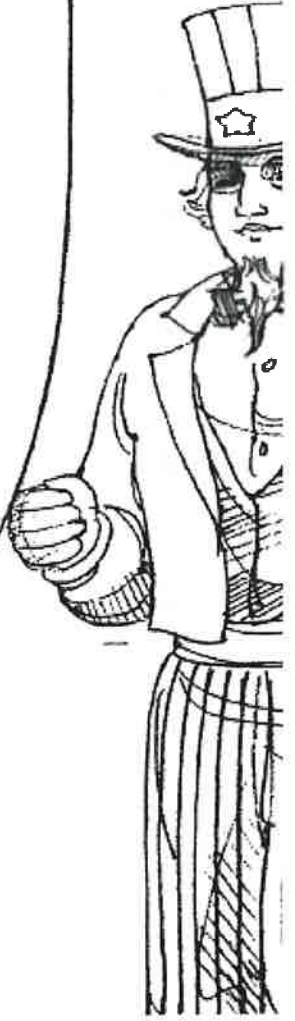

Rights retained by people

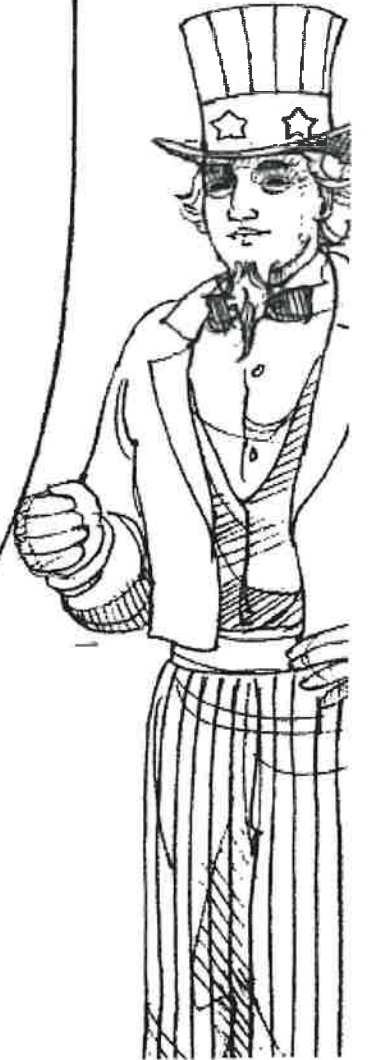
Powers reserved to states any power not listed in the Constitution is reserved for the states
